

Texas Title Transfer Information

Each Texas Certificate of Title must be transferred to the winning bidder. Each Certificate of Title must be signed by the Seller on the front of the Texas Certificate of Title on the "Signature of Owner" line. The back of each Title needs to be completed, as well. Under the "Assignment of Title" section next to the Date of Sale box it should be signed on the "Signature of Seller/Agent" line and should be printed on the "Printed Name (same as signature)" line. After the vehicle has been sold and paid for you will need to complete the "Name of Purchaser, Street, City, State and Zip" line with the winning bidder's information in the "Assignment of Title" section.

Please note: The Name of Purchaser line MUST be completed and MAY NOT be left blank. Title can only be transferred to the winning bidder's name or company name as it appears on the receipt we email to you.

An Application for Texas Title (Form Number 130-U) must be completed and accompany each title. You can download both the Application for Texas Title (Form Number 130-U) and the Instructions for Completing Form 130-U (Form Number VTR-130-UIF) under the "Forms" section of our website.

When a Texas-titled vehicle is sold the seller needs to notify TxDMV by completing a Vehicle Transfer Notification. This can be done online at:
